LEVEL 1

\$130

Observation only with or without an IV catheter. Seizure watch or cardiac cases are required to have an IVC in place. **Level 1 includes exam, hospitalization, observation** (vitals Q6, including either 1 blood pressure or 1 EKG reading per shift), **and IV catheter care.** IV catheter and IV fluid(s) as well as PO medications are to be provided by you, including antibiotics and pain medications.

LEVEL 2

\$170

These are stable cases that require continued IV catheter and pain management, such as post-operative orthopedic cases. **Level 2 includes exam, hospitalization, observation** (vitals Q6, including either 1 blood pressure or 1 EKG reading per shift) **and IV catheter care.** IV catheter and IV fluid(s) as well as PO medications are to be provided by you, including antibiotics and pain medications. IV pain management will be provided by AMVS.

LEVEL 3

\$200

These are stable cases that require continued IV fluid, pain management, and diagnostic monitoring, such as post-operative abdominal cases. **Level 3 includes exam, hospitalization, observation** (vitals Q6, including either 1 blood pressure or 1 EKG reading per shift) **and IV catheter care.** IV catheter and IV fluid(s) as well as PO medications are to be provided by you, including antibiotics and pain medications. IV pain management will be provided by AMVS. 1 EPOC (blood gas, electrolytes, and creatinine) and 1 PCV/TS is also included in level 3.

LEVEL 4

\$250

Non-surgical cases that require medical management including supportive fluid therapy for rehydration +/- pain management. **Level 4 includes exam, hospitalization, observation, and IV catheter care.** IV catheter and IV fluid(s) as well as PO medications are to be provided by you, including antibiotics and pain medications. IV pain management will be provided by AMVS. 2 EPOC (blood gas, electrolytes, and creatinine), 1 PCV/TS, and 2 blood pressure readings are included in level 4 in addition to vitals Q6. Feeding can be administered through a feeding tube as long as a placement radiograph is available for viewing. These cases include hepatic lipidosis cats, stable GE, pancreatitis patients, etc.
