

Ultrasound Request Form

- If the patient arrives in an unstable condition a doctor's exam and consultation will be performed prior to the ultrasound.
- Mild sedation is routinely given during the ultrasound in order to provide quality, diagnostic images as well as providing comfort to the patient.
- Please advise owners that the patient must be fasted after midnight the night before the ultrasound. Water is okay.
- Most outpatient ultrasounds are worked into the day as a drop off. Please advise owners that they will drop off in the morning and pick up the afternoon.
- Outpatient ultrasound results will be reported directly to the referring veterinarian. The specialist will not talk with client unless consult is requested.
